Portlet Roles Defined

The following roles are the standard, default roles applicable to your portal. Privileges per role are applied to portal pages, portlets, articles, documents, and images. Your organization may also have added custom roles, with specified privileges.

Role Name	Definition
Guest	Non-authenticated access. Users do not need to be logged in to the portal to view/access pages, portlets, articles, images, or documents.
Owner	The authenticated user that created the item.
User	Authenticated access; Users must be logged into the portal to view/access pages, portlets, articles, images, or documents.
Organization User	All users of the organization become members of the site added to the organization automatically. They have access to the private pages of the site and are able to do any action that has been configured to be doable only by site members. Organization users are also users of the parent organization.
Site Member	Site Members are assigned to a site. All users who belong to a site have this role within that site. They have access to both the private and public pages of a site.

Workflow Roles

The following are single approver workflow roles. Workflow roles both review and approve content in the portal.

Role Name	Definition
Community Content Reviewer	Community Content Reviewers can review content at the community level.
Organization Content Reviewer	Organization Content Reviewers can review content at the organization level.
Portal Content Reviewer	Portal Content Reviewers can review content at the portal level.
Site Content Reviewer	Site Content Reviewers can review content at the site level.
